RE: Proposed Regulation LAC 61:I.1915- Small Town Health Professionals Credit

Chairman Abramson and Chairman Morrell:

On September 10, 2019 a copy of the *Notice of Intent* issued by the Department of Revenue for promulgation of the proposed regulation, LAC 61:I.1915, *Small Town Health Professionals Credit*, was sent to your committee for review. The purpose of this *Notice of Intent* is to extend eligibility for the Small Town Health Professionals credit to primary care physicians assistants and optometrists, in accordance with Act 338 of the 2019 Regular Session of the Louisiana Legislature.

The *Notice of Intent* was published in the September 2019 issue of the *Louisiana Register*. A public hearing was held on Monday, October 28, 2019. No written or oral comments were received. In addition, one attendee was present at the public hearing. No changes will be made to the text of the rule before it is finalized.

This report is being made in accordance with R.S. 47:968(D)(1)(b) of the Administrative Procedure Act. Unless otherwise directed, the proposed rule will be submitted for publication as a final rule in the October 2019 edition of the *Louisiana Register*.
