On October 10, 2019 a copy of the *Notice of Intent* issued by the Louisiana Sales and Use Tax Commission for Remote Sellers (the "Commission") for the promulgation of the proposed regulation LAC 61:III.2901 and 2903, *Policy Statements and Guidance*, was sent to your committee for review. The purpose of this *Notice of Intent* is to enable the Louisiana Sales and Use Tax Commission for Remote Sellers to issue various policy statements to communicate the Commission's position and to ensure the correct, consistent and fair enforcement of tax laws.

The *Notice of Intent* was published in the October 2019 issue of the *Louisiana Register*. A public hearing was held in the LaSalle Building on Tuesday, November 25, 2019.
