§21519. Exposure to Loss

A. The commissioner may allow a captive insurance company, except an association captive insurance company, or a risk retention group chartered and licensed in this state to expose itself to loss on a single risk in an amount up to thirty percent of the capital and surplus of the captive insurance company or risk retention group. A risk, or any portion thereof, which has been reinsured shall be deducted in determining the limitation of risk prescribed in the Section.
