2019 Judicial Interest Rate to Be Paid On Refunds¹

The judicial interest rate, which is the rate the Department uses to pay interest on refunds of overpayments, has been set by the Office of Financial Institutions at six (6.00) percent effective January 1, 2019 through December 31, 2019.

LA Revised Statute 47:1624(A) provides that the Department will pay interest on refunds at the judicial interest rate established by the Commissioner of the Office of Financial Institutions in accordance with LA R.S. 13:4202.
