

Electronic Funds Transfer:

the smart way to pay your Louisiana business taxes

Wouldn't it be great if you could take care of your tax payments without all the hassles of writing and mailing checks?

You can—with **Electronic Funds Transfer (EFT)**.

You're in control with EFT.

Payments can't get lost or delayed in the mail, and you can pay when it's convenient—24 hours a day, 7 days a week. The call for debit payers must be completed before 1:30 p.m. Central Time at least one business day before you want your bank account debited. The call is toll-free.

EFT is easy.

When you choose the ACH debit method, a phone call is all it takes to authorize payment.

EFT is secure.

- ☞ You have complete control of the movement of your money.
- ☞ The funds can only be deposited to the State of Louisiana's bank account.
- ☞ Your transaction is protected by a security access code.
- ☞ You get a verification number at the end of each call, so your transaction can be tracked.

There are two ways to pay electronically—debit transfers or credit transfers.

Debit transfers

To authorize payments, you call the Department's banking service, a toll-free number, using either touch-tone automation, personal computer, or operator assistance. You specify the amount to be transferred, and the service will then transfer that amount from your bank account to the Department's account. The state pays the transaction cost for the debit option.

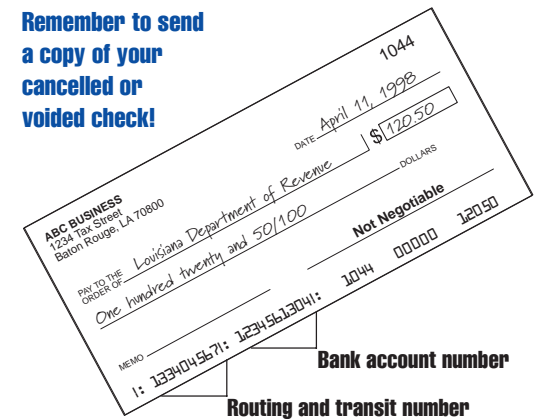
Credit transfers

To authorize payment with a credit transfer, you have your bank transfer funds to the state's bank account. (Supplemental filing information must be sent with your payment using the ACH standard CCD+ format and TXP Addendum Record standards. Contact your bank to make sure they offer ACH origination services.) The cost of each transaction is charged to you, as the originator of the credit transfer.

Getting started is easy

Fill out the form on the back and mail it to us. We'll send you an EFT instruction packet. If you're choosing the debit transfer option, be sure to include a copy of a cancelled or voided check from your account.

Remember to send a copy of your cancelled or voided check!
