

The partnership return is due on the fifteenth day of the fourth month following the close of the taxable year. If you received an extension to file your federal tax return for this period, you do not need to apply for a separate extension for your state return. Louisiana will recognize and accept the federal extension authorizing the same extended due date as the federal. Attach a copy of your federal application, Federal Form 7004, to your completed Louisiana return.

If you do not have a federal extension, you should use this form to apply for a state extension. The maximum time allowed is six months past the due date of the Louisiana return.

Follow the country's practice for entering the postal code and the name of the province, county, or state. Enter the foreign country name in the appropriate space. Don't abbreviate the country name.
